Measuring VMMC Sustainability: Development of VMMC Regional SID

- Modeled on the PEPFAR Sustainability Index and Dashboard (SID) with same domains, elements, tool structure
- Adapted questions to be specific for VMMC and focused Domain B (National System and Service Delivery questions for 3 geographic regions of focus)
- Piloted tool in Tanzania in 2016 with 50 participants from civil society, private sector, NACP, regional representatives from Iringa, Njombe, and Tabora, UNICEF, PEPFAR



What is VMMC Sustainability?

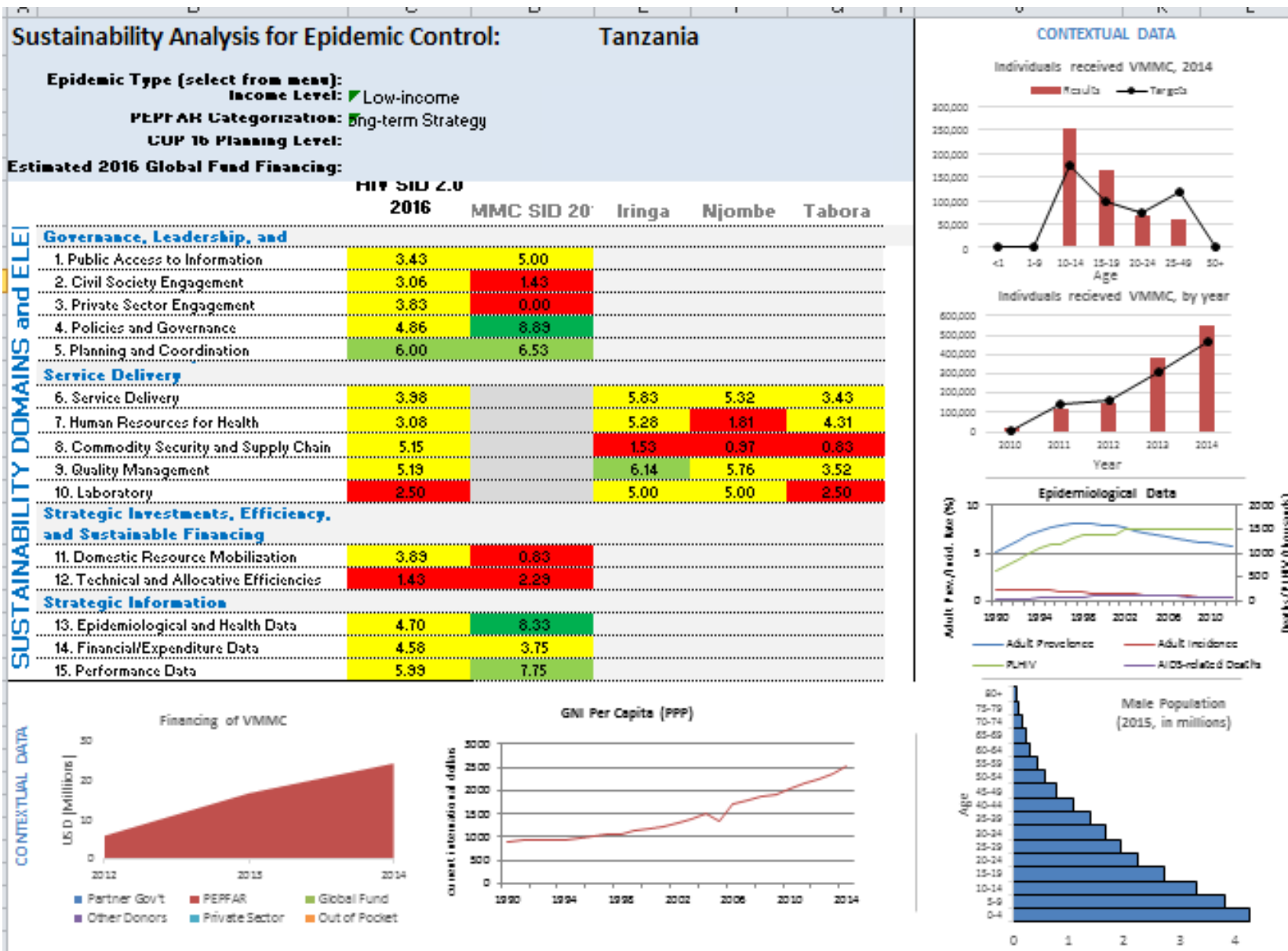
A local system can maintain high male circumcision prevalence within a geographical area after the initial coverage target is reached

- *Working Definition for VMMC Sustainability Meeting, 2016*

Health facilities provide regular, high quality client centered VMMC services delivered by competent providers with adequate commodities and funding to sustain 80% circumcision coverage
