

DREAMS Target Population

Adolescent Girls and Young Women (AGYW)

- HIV negative FSW
- Negative pregnant AGYW
- Married Adolescents (15-19)
- Given birth (15-24)
- In school: (10-14); (15-19)
- Uganda targeted to identify and follow-up about 335,000 AGYW (15-24) over a two year period

<u>Men</u>

• Males in sexual networks

Community engagement

- Parents/guardians
- Cultural, religious, community gate keepers, schools
- AGYW's community

Uganda DREAMS Coordination Model

- Active engagement at the national, district and community level National:
- Coordination with relevant line ministries:
 - Health, Defense, Education, and Gender, Labor and Social Development
 - MOH is the lead coordinator of all "DREAMS" line ministries.
 - The MOH's Adolescent TWG now includes DREAMS POC's from the three clusters, and PEPFAR representatives.
 - The MOH Adolescent TWG comprises representatives from the School _ Health program, the Reproductive Health Division, The Adolescent Health Desk, The Aids Control Program and STD unit.
- Coordination with other Development partners and other ۲ stakeholders : UNICEF, UNAIDS, FBO's, CSO's, Cultural Institutions

Uganda DREAMS Coordination Model

District:

- Though Community Development Officers, Probation Officers, Health Education officers, District Education Officers, Local Government
- All 10 DREAMS districts have a DREAMS Lead under the chief administrators office who coordinates DREAMS activities
- Implementing Partners, using existing platforms

Community:

- Implementing Partners, CBO's, CSO's, Para-social workers, Village Health Teams, Peers
- Community cultural, religious leadership
- Role of QI teams attached to AGYW stepping stones groups
- Peer led referrals, linkages, and tracking and follow-up "DREAMS Ambassadors"





Uganda DREAMS Monitoring and Evaluation

Mentored

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- Utilization of programmatic data
 - Individual tracking of each AGYW using a unique identifier across service delivery points, DREAMS passports and sim card tracker.
 - All partners using DHIS2 web-based database for enrollment and tracking <u>http://dreams.mets.or.ug/dhis-web-commons/security/login.action</u>



DREAMS Accomplishments – To date

All IPS have made substantial gains in achievement against targets in the last 2 quarters considering late start of actual implementation

- VMMC achieved 66,623, in 10 SNUs
- HTC yield above 5% in all districts

Resilient

• Achieved 86% of AGYW enrollment target

- Layering of services happening, with variations by sub-population, agency and IP



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

Synergy with VMMC and DREAMS

- PEPFAR Level:
 - VMMC TWG members part of DREAMS weekly meetings
 - Joint field monitoring visits between DREAMS team and VMMC TWG to ensure that the IPs are layering interventions and effectively linking male partners
 - Addressing challenges where the district DREAMS IP is not the same VMMC IP
- DREAMS platforms used for VMMC demand Creation
 - The male sexual characterization assessment
 - DREAMS Ambassadors, Girls Engagement Forums
 - Stepping Stones QI Teams model; AGYW male partner champions
 - FP outreaches leveraged for VMMC TT
 - School family health initiative.
 - Leveraging DREAMS OVC platforms





Implementation Challenges and Actions

Use of standardized service delivery and data reporting tools, Hybrid for age disaggregation
Regular partner coordination meetings, enhance linkage through peer led system, VHTs and Social workers,
DREAMS Passport with unique IDS and sim card tracking system, Uganda DREAMS tracking system.
Multi-pronged mobilization and reminder systems. Revised health communications and data tools.
