


National programme and services for sustained adolescent services -VMMC



Mozambique



- Population: 28,751,263 (projected 2016)
- HIV infection prevalence: 11.5% (INSIDA, 2009)
- MoH adopted VMMC as a HIV prevention strategy in 2011
- Male circumcision coverage: 51% (INSIDA, 2009), 63% (IMASIDA, 2015)
- MoH target to circumcise 2 million Mozambican males (10-49 yo) from 2013-2017

What is being done for program sustainability

- Increase in staff numbers (MoH) trained and certified for VMMC delivery.
- Greater interaction and integration of VMMC activities at health unity context.
- Distribution of consumables through the MoH in two provinces
- Indication of MoH professionals as heads of VMMC services.
- Coordination meetings of VMMC IPs with Health Offices in each province.

What will be done

- Continue previous activities.
- More integration of VMMC program into the HIV program context at central level in demand creation, HIV testing, service delivery, supply chain management
- Permanent monitoring of VMMC unities by province health offices using existing quality instruments (MoH).

What will be done

- Greater interaction with other programs (maternal and child health, school health, health education,...) at central and province level.
- Enhance interaction with other sectors (community based organizations, religious institutions, ministry of youth and sports).
